#### APPLICATION FOR HOME EDUCATION

The instruction of one or two students in a home setting is not a school per se Rather, it is a tutorial program. Section 13-1327 of the School Code states that "regular daily instruction ... for the time herein required, by a properly qualified private tutor, shall be considered as complying with the provisions of this section, if such instruction is satisfactory to the proper county or district superintendent of schools." Responsibility for overseeing private tutorial programs is obviously placed upon the district superintendents, and the courts have recognized this delegation of responsibility. The court in Commonwealth vs. Kallock, 84 PLJ 167, 27D & C-81 (1936) stated that "any private tutoring must be satisfactory to the proper county or district superintendent of schools." See also, Commonwealth vs. Luther, 47 Northumb. L.J. 117 (1975).
