Thank you to all who stopped by and helped make this a great night!

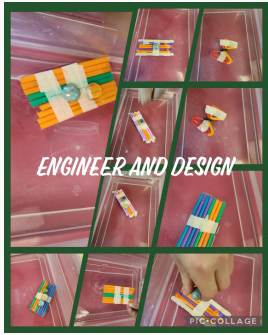


## 3D Club Helped decorate the Creepy Maze.

They used technology and their imaginations to create scary decorations and props. The club named them, "Terror-ific Tools of Technology." They used 3D printers to print hollow and transparent skulls, and put lights in them to give them a creepy glow. There were also 3D printed little ghosts using "glow in the dark" filament so that they would glow in the creepy maze and appear like they were flying around. Students also used 3D pens to create spooky vampire bats, skeleton bones, coffins, and cauldrons full of spooky brew. And to add a little fun, they used 3D printers to print out classic Halloween characters such as Frankenstein and mummies.

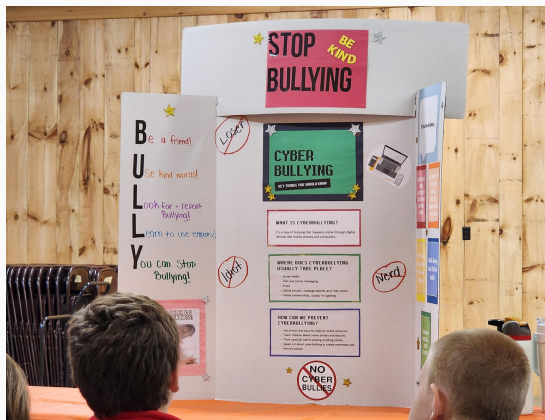
## Ithaca Science Center

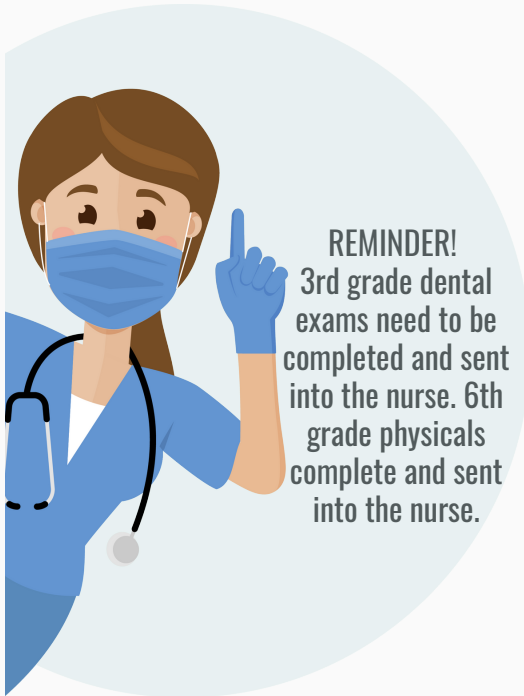


**Bettina Campbell Day at TIS!**

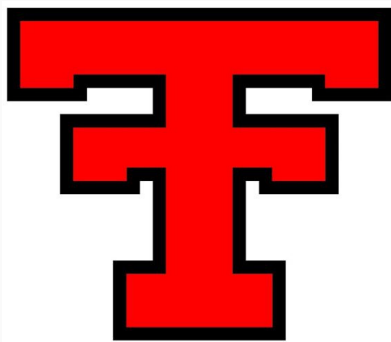

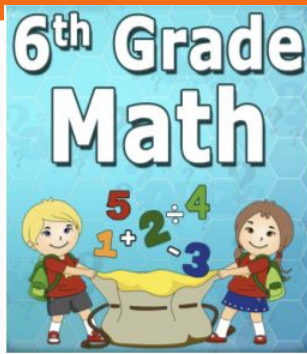
