A MESSAGE FROM MR. WILCOX

As we spring forward, please remember that proper sleep is an important aid and boost for a student's immune system. Attendance is important as we wind down the year and wrap up the last of our standardized testing starting Mid- March through Mid-May. If you are unaware the district policy allows a parent or guardian to excuse a child for up to 10 days of absences. After the initial ten a doctor's note is required. If you exceed your maximum days and your child reaches three unexcused days a SAIP meeting will occur to discuss possible changes to improve attendance. If these behaviors don't improve the district must file with the local magistrate as it is illegal to exceed 6 or more unexcused days.
